



## Call for Papers Bayreuth-Kulmbach Workshop on Global Health Politics

This workshop seeks to provide researchers of all career stages an inspiring forum for in-depth discussion of their current research projects in the field of *global health politics*. For the purpose of this workshop, global health politics encompasses health policy and politics in the Global South as well as health policy development at the inter- and transnational level.

While the workshop is thematically focused on the politics of global health, it is open to researchers from a variety of disciplines, including political science, public policy, sociology, history and anthropology as well as health and nutrition sciences. Proposed papers should be grounded in solid empirical research.

Potential topics include but are definitely not limited to:

- Politics of Universal Health Coverage
- Health policy responses to the Covid-19 pandemic
- Reform processes of relevant international institutions, e.g., WHO or TRIPS Agreement
- Politics of NCD prevention, e.g., diet and tobacco control

The workshop will follow *Korpi's Rules*, according to which papers are read by participants in advance and then presented by an assigned discussant rather than the authors themselves. This necessitates that participants circulate complete drafts of their papers well before the workshop.

The workshop is hosted by Tim Dorlach and the Junior Professorship of Global Nutrition and Health Policy at the University of Bayreuth's new satellite campus in *Kulmbach*. The workshop is funded by a Conference Grant from the University of Bayreuth's Junior Scholar Office (WiN-UBT).

The workshop can cover accommodation costs in Kulmbach (for three nights) as well as travel expenses (within certain limits) for all participants.
